

Preparing your game:


1. Cut out the counters below, fold along the dotted lines and apply glue to the edge.

Answer a question asked by your opponants. Move forward 2 spaces if you answer correctly, otherwise go back 2 spaces.




Roll again.




A storm! You have to take shelter, move back 2 spaces.













Personalised photo frame

1. Colour and cut out the frame.






3. Stick the pictures on to the frame.




4. Choose your favourite holiday photo and stick your personalised frame on top of it! You can reinforce it with cardboard first if you like.







How to make your vocabulary book

Colour in the pictures then cut out the pages of the notebook and fold along the dotted lines.








Travel diary
